

LINKING THE PROBLEM

What is the Problem?

Glue a large, blank notecard to a piece of colored paper. Each card should be mounted on a different color.

These cards are laminated so they may be written on by students.

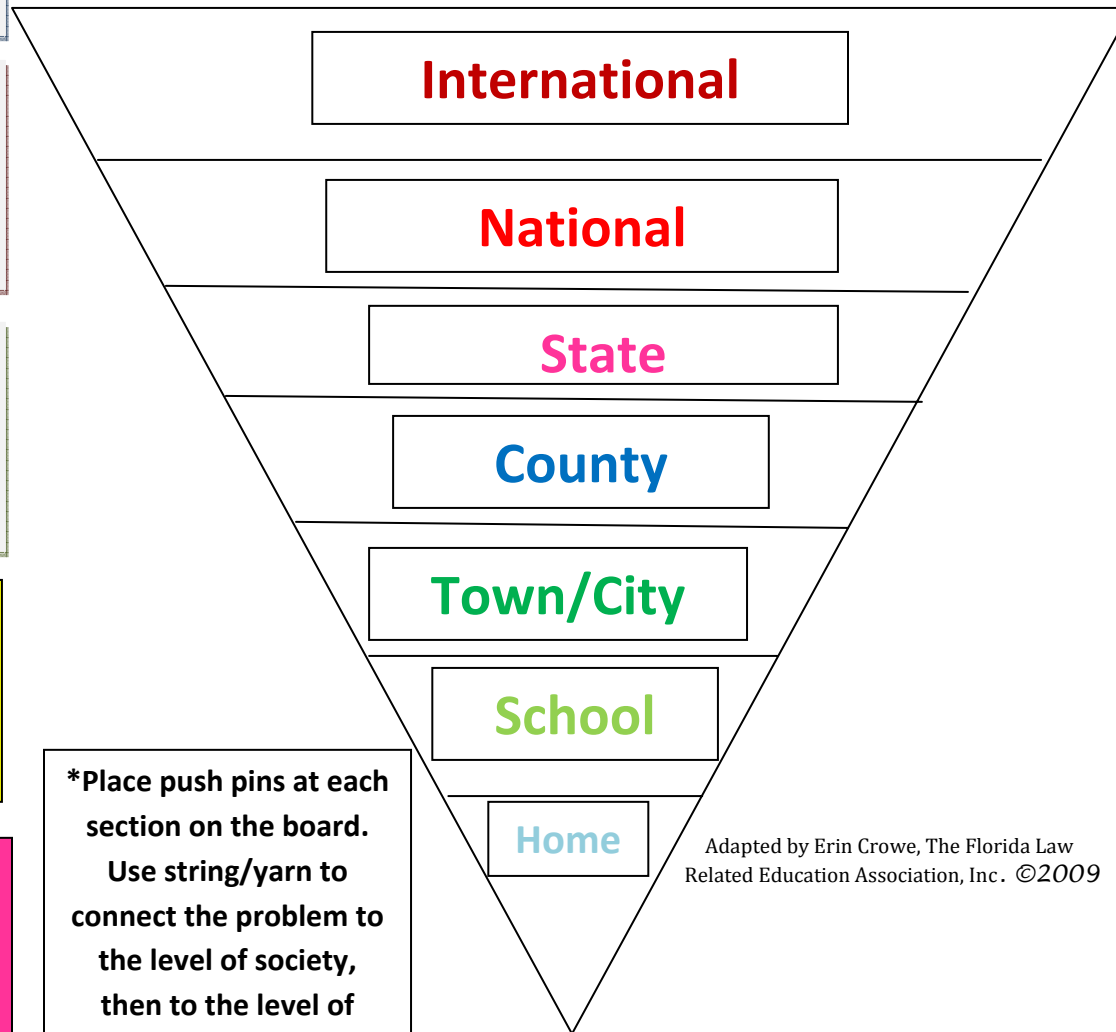
There is Velcro attached to the back so they may be removed from the board and written on by students.

Each card should be a different color and have matching yarn so it is clear which problem is being linked throughout.

Use newspaper articles, CNN student news, or other media students may analyze to identify problems.

To what level of society can we link this problem?

To what level of government can we link this problem?



Place push pins at each section on the board. Use string/yarn to connect the problem to the level of society, then to the level of government.
